



TECHNICAL RIDER

Purchaser agrees to provide a professional sound system in good to excellent working condition appropriately sized to cover the entire room. The system shall minimally consist of the following:

1. A quality sound system that has at least one (1) standard microphone input (XLR) for a music player provided by the Artist.
2. A wireless handheld microphone with a microphone stand (straight stand) to be used by audience members who are onstage.

NOTE: A wireless handheld microphone is preferred however a wired handheld microphone is acceptable. Audience members CANNOT use a lavalier microphone.

3. One Shure bodypack and receiver. Artist will provide a Shure compatible headset to plug into the bodypack you provide.

NOTE: Please make sure the wireless handheld and the bodypack you provide is using separate receivers and frequencies to avoid interference and ensure quality sound.

4. Access to the performance area at least one (1) hour prior to the start time of the program indicated on the entertainment agreement.

NOTE: Performance area must be no less than 10'x12' and free of all cords, cables, podiums, and any other obstructions. Please have stairs from the FRONT of the stage if possible.

5. Two (2) standard electrical outlets (120v or 240v)

6. A projection screen and projector that includes an HDMI input.

NOTE: A large television or LED display screen large enough for the viewing audience is also acceptable.

7. One (1) laptop to play video content (Laptop should have VLC player installed.) Artist will supply a USB drive to supply the video content. Artist will also bring an iPad Pro with an HDMI output as an alternative.

NOTE: The videos supplied by the artist contain audio that will need to be played through the sound system. If audio is not hardwired to the sound system then any required audio cables will need to be provided.

8. One small card table (or comparable) to hold the artists props on stage. A larger table is acceptable but not needed. Purchaser is responsible for providing copies of this technical rider to the appropriate personnel no less than two (2) weeks prior to the engagement.
